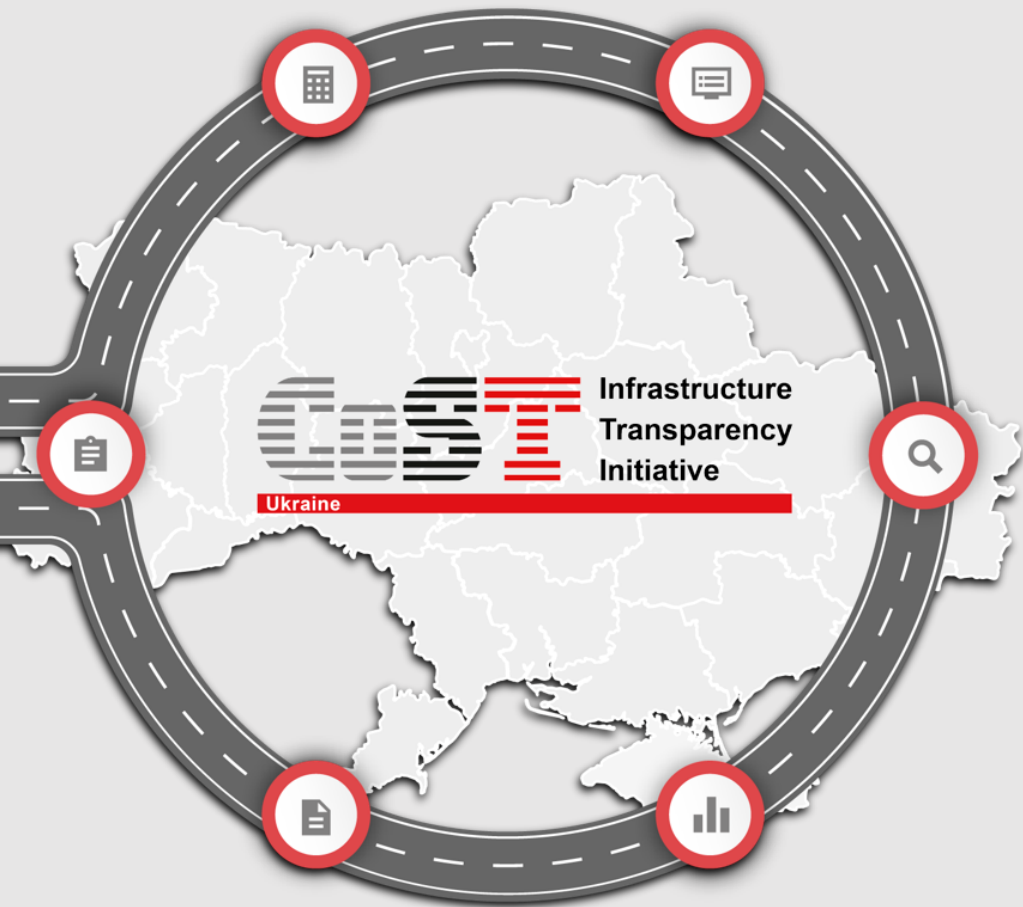

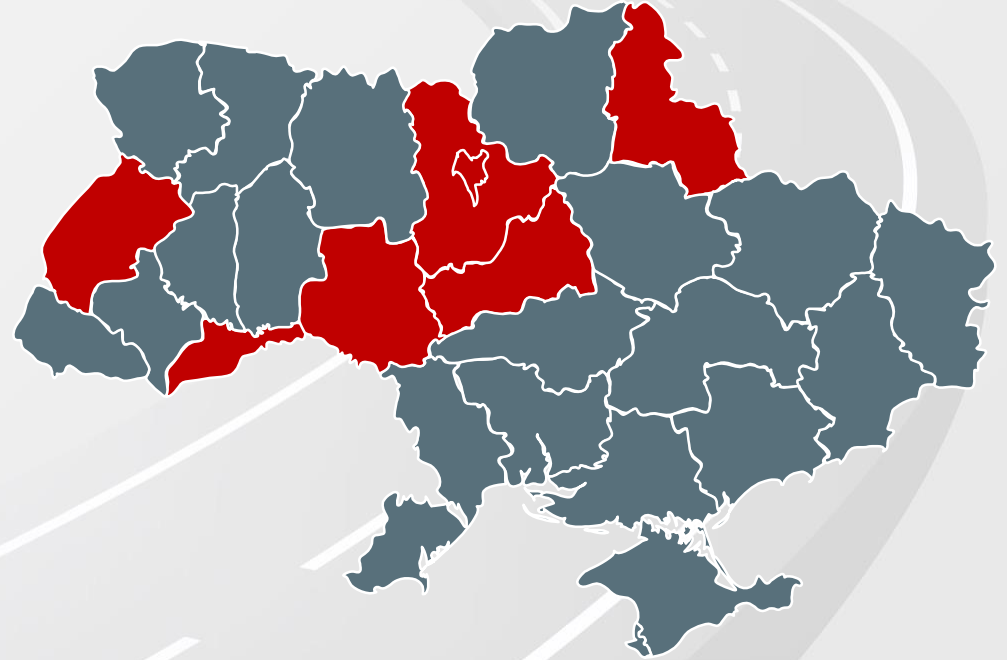


REGIONAL NETWORK OF CIVIC MONITORS

2019: 6 REGIONS COVERED BY REGIONAL COORDINATORS

3 trained regional coordinators:

- supported local communities and activists with the road quality monitoring;
- trained citizens on how to participate in addressing community's problems through constructive engagement and partnerships with the government;
- Supported local and regional government to identify road defects and procurement risks.
