What we learned so far

- Since 2016, EBRD is working with UNCITRAL Secretariat and WTO Secretariat on developing transparency standards datasets to help GLOBAL standard for public procurement Open Data fit all jurisdiction

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- Several prototypes of the OCDS digital tools were piloted and idea of smart public contract register building on BI technology conceived
- New opportunities: Develop a pilot of OCDS smart public contract for EU Member States



OCDS – Open Contracting Data Standard facilitates digital transformation in public procurement

- The globally recognized data standard for public budgets, tenders and contracts
- Compliant with Open Government Data Standard
- Process-based - covers procurement cycle from planning to payment
- Community owned - practitioners propose OCDS extensions as needed for their country procurement systems
- High reusability - OCDS is used for disclosure as well as modern data integration (REST API)
- Fully Open Source

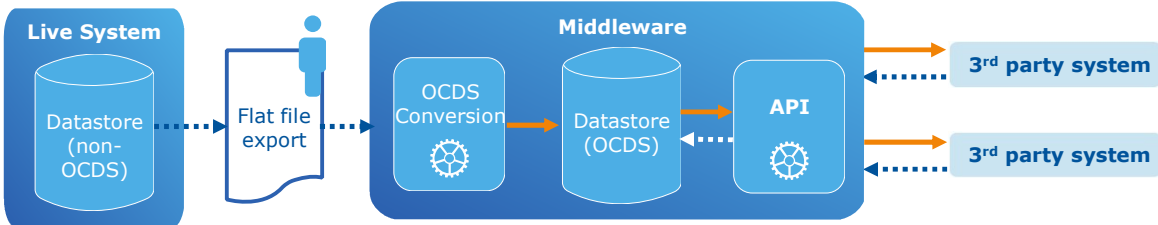
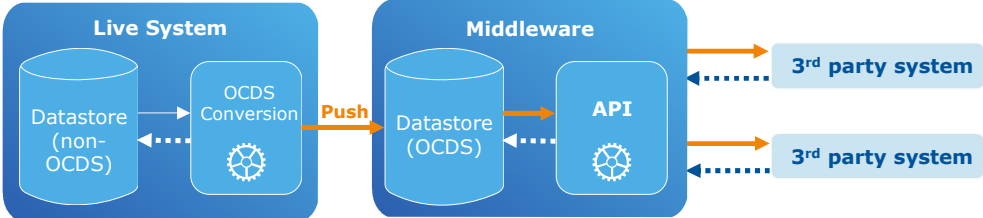
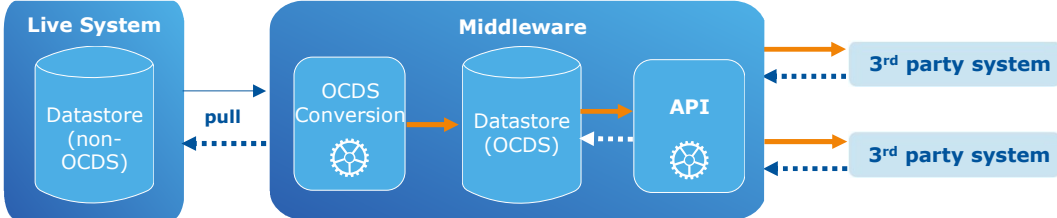
Implementation
